- Purpose of the event:** The Arts in Nature Festival is a multigenerational celebration of art in nature and the beauty of creating. Art, music, storytelling, writing, poetry and homesteading arts will take place in and around the Georgetown Nature Area including the amphitheater, Nisenan Village, and Peace Pole. There will be a children's areas for educational activities and just playing and an avenue of vendors selling a variety of items including food, and information booths by local organizations and students.
- Gates will **open at 7:00 AM** and all booths must be **set up by 9:00 AM**. Once the event has started, no vehicles will be allowed in the area before 4:00 PM.
- A fee of \$25 will be charged for vendors selling non-food items (crafts, clothing, instruments, etc).** **Late registration fee after deadline of April 14 is \$35.** Food vendor fee is \$50. No fee for non-profit organizations or school groups. *If vendors and non-profits wish, they may donate an item for a silent auction to benefit Friends of the Nature Area, the sponsor of this event.*
- Space is limited. Space assignment is on a first come first serve basis. Chairperson has right to help choose space. Booth spaces are approximately 12' x 12'.
- All non-profit booths must provide a free activity for children in addition to showcasing their organization.**
- Applicants are fully responsible for providing, setting up, taking down, and cleaning up their own booths.
- Please plan to pack out your own trash.
- Please prepare for any kind of weather, a booth cover for sun or rain is highly recommended.
- Electrical service is limited and must be reserved early.
- This is an alcohol, drug and tobacco free family event.**
